

SAA INDOOR RANKINGS FOR LONGBOW AND BAREBOW 2009-10

There will be an indoor rankings list this year for all Longbow and Barebow SAA archers who shoot at competition.

The rankings will be back-dated to the start of this seasons indoor tournaments. Rounds that will be included are all 5 dozen rounds which are shot in open competition.

All scores will be converted to FITA 18 scores using the same table as is used for the Recurve / Compound rankings.

FITA rounds: if you shoot in both sessions, both scores will count for ranking purposes.

GNAS Imperial rounds: if you shoot in both sessions, only you're a.m. score will count for rankings.

To gain a position in the rankings, you must shoot a minimum of 3 competition rounds during the season. (Your best 3 rounds will be used to determine your place in the rankings.)

The rankings list will be compiled by Brenda Williams of Bannockburn Bowmen, and will be published on the SAA website as they are updated.

It is your responsibility to check that the scores listed are correct and that any omissions / errors are notified to me by email to bannockburnbowmen@hotmail.co.uk. Please mark it "RANKINGS" in the subject area.

If you shoot a round outwith Scotland and wish to have it included in your scores, please email details of your score, your bowstyle, your name, your club, where you shot the round and where results of the tournament can be verified.
