OPEN PAPINGO & BUTT ROUND. SUNDAY 10th AUGUST 2008.

You, and all members of your club are cordially invited to take part in the Ancient Society's Butt Round and Open Papingo shoot at Kilwinning on Sunday 10th of August 2008.

Date: Sunday 10th August 2008

Place: Butt Round: McGavin Park, Kilwinning.
Papingo: Abbey Tower, Kilwinning.

Time: Assembly for the Butt Round: 0945 for First arrows at 1000.
The Papingo will commence as soon as possible after the Butt Round finishes.

Rounds: The Butt Round will comprise 6 dozen arrows shot in ends of 3, from 30 yards, towards an individual nine inch diameter three zone face.
The Papingo is 100 feet from the ground. The order of merit at the butts will determine the order of shooting at the Papingo.

Equipment: At the Butts, any bow may be used. Compounds must be shot off the fingers and are limited to 60 lbs at the archer's draw length. Longbows are limited to 70 lbs.
At the Papingo, the Society will provide both bows and arrows.

Awards: At the Butts: first, second and third places, overall, will be rewarded for modern bows and also for longbows.
At the Tower; the archer who first 'Dings down the Doo' will be awarded the Wallace Rose Bowl and a medal. Archers who dislodge wings will receive a rosette.

Entries: The line is limited, by space, to 40 archers. Entries will close on Tuesday 5th August 2008. Late entries will only be accepted if there is space on the line. Entries will only be acknowledged if they cannot be accepted due to the line being full.

The shooting fee is £3.00 for seniors and £1.50 for juniors. Entries and fees, **cheque made out to ASKA**, to the Secretary, at the address above, please. Include an email contact or SAE if you want a printed copy of the results.

Food: None will be provided. Please bring your own.

Juniors: Juniors are most welcome at this shoot, **BUT they must be in the company of either a parent or an adult nominated by their parent in writing.**
