DRESS REGULATIONS

As this is a British Record Status Event, all archers must comply with G.N.A.S. Dress Regulations.

DRUG TESTING

All archers attending this tournament will be liable to drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply: if any competitor refuses, that refusal will be treated as a positive results.

Entry forms submitted on behalf of archers under the age of 18 must be signed by their parents or guardian confirming that such archer will be permitted to submit to a drug test if requested to do so.

INSURANCE

This tournament is only open to members of G.N.A.S or other recognised Archery Societies provided that Public Liability Insurance cover of at least £2,000,000 is in place.

All archers should be able to produce their G.N.A.S. membership cards on the day of the competition if requested by the Judge or Tournament Organiser. Archers unable to produce their membership cards may not be permitted to shoot.

CHILD PROTECTION

This shoot will be run in accordance with the Child Protection procedures as defined by GNAS and SAA

PARENTS/GUARDIANS

Parents, or their representatives will be responsible for the care of their children while those children participate in this tournament. Glasgow Archers do not have any control over photography at this event.

SCANDINAVIAN FITA

A SCANDINAVIAN FITA IS A STANDARD FITA ROUND, WITH THE SAME NUMBER OF ARROWS SHOT AT THE SAME DISTANCES AS NORMAL.

HOWEVER, THE ARROWS ARE SHOT IN THREE ARROW ENDS FROM START TO FINISH.

THERE WILL THREE ARCHERS PER TARGET (MAXIMUM). THE ARCHERS SHOOT SIMULTANEOUSLY EXCEPT FOR THE FIRST END OF EACH DISTANCE WHEN THEY HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY OF SHOOTING IN SEQUENCE.

THE FIRST END OF EACH DISTANCE IS SHOT THUS:

90/70 METRES	A,B,C.	70/60 METRES	B,C,A.
50 METRES	C,A,B.	30 METRES	A,B,C.

THROUGHOUT THE SHOOT ENDS WILL BE SHOT AS THREE ARROW IN TWO MINUTES
