Rules The tournament will be held under current GNAS rules including the use of alternative shooting colours registered and approved by GNAS. Proof of GNAS membership may be required.

Trophies Trophies are only awarded to archers shooting the rounds for which they are eligible or a higher than specified round for that age group. Second and third places will be awarded according to entry.

Drug Testing: This shoot could be drug tested and competitors approached for samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. To this end a parent's or guardian's signature must be provided on the entry form for all competitors who are under 18.

Novice is defined as an archer who is in his or her first affiliated season with GNAS, provided that he or she has not been affiliated to any other British or FITA affiliated body. The Novice Trophies will be awarded to those who are 21 or over for the National round unless an alternative round, agreed prior to the shoot commences, is acceptable to all parties.

All current trophy holders are requested to return or arrange for the trophies to be returned (cleaned) on or before the day of the competition.
