One end of practice arrows will be shot, starting at 9:00 a.m.
Equipment inspection will be undertaken between practice and the commencement of the competition.

Shooting both days	£21.00
Shooting one day only	£12.00

(all entry fees are non-returnable)

Full adult fees are chargeable for juniors shooting senior rounds.

Dress Regulations

As this is a British Record Status event, all archers will be expected to comply with current G.N.A.S. dress regulations Rule 307

Drug Testing

All archers attending this Tournament will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to provide samples must comply; if any competitor refuses to undertake a drug test that refusal will be treated as a positive result.

Entry Forms submitted on behalf of archers under the age of 18 must be signed by their parent or guardian confirming that they agree to abide by this rule, and authorising drug testing on such competitors.

Insurance

This tournament is only open to members of G.N.A.S. or other recognised Archery Society affiliated to F.I.T.A

All archers must be able to produce their G.N.A.S. membership cards (or other written evidence of membership from their Club Secretary) on the day of the tournament if so requested by the Judge or Tournament Organiser. Archers unable to do so may not be permitted to shoot.

Child Protection:

The SAA takes its responsibility in relation to Child Protection legislation (including vulnerable adults) extremely seriously. This shoot will therefore be run in accordance with the Child Protection procedures as defined by GNAS and SAA.

Parents / Guardians Please Note:

Parents, or their representatives, will be responsible for the care of those children while those children participate in this tournament. The Scottish Archery Association, and Glasgow Archers, have no control over photography at this event.

Shooting

The following method of shooting will be adopted:

- There will be a maximum of four archers per boss.
- At 90/70 : 70/60 metres distances 6 arrow ends will be shot within 4 minutes
- At 50 & 30 metres, 3 arrow ends will be shot within 2 minutes.

Scoring

In accordance with G.N.A.S. Rules the following scoring system will be adopted:
Double score boards whereby two archers record all the scores and if there is a discrepancy between the two boards, the lower score will be counted.

Camping & Caravaning

A fee of £7 per tent/caravan is applied for those camping on the field ~please include the appropriate fee on your entry form

Distance Awards (all disciplines)

The top 3 Medal winners will be excluded from distance awards. In order for all distance awards to be awarded there will require to be more than 10 other competitors. Where there are 7-9 other competitors, scores will be combined to provide awards for the best 'Long Metric and Short Metric scores. These awards will be personalized SAA certificates.
