| Start Time | <p>The organisers will arrive on the field at 10:00am and the shoot will commence when the field is all set up. Approx 10:30 am Assistance would be appreciated. The shoot will finish when 36 X 2 arrows have been shot (excluding sighters) and scored. Approx 3:30 PM</p> |
| What can we expect? | <p>Have fun – remember you could be shooting your arrows into a field which is used for grazing cows</p> |

| | <p>and sheep – read into that what you will!</p> <p>The Arniston Clout shoot will be shot in a single direction – 36 arrows x 2 sets. Arrows are shot from the shooting line towards the clout target, scored and collected. There will be a lunch break between the sets.</p> <p>You will be given 6 sighter arrows. There are separate gents, ladies and junior targets. Gents will shoot at 165 metres, ladies 125 metres and there will be separate junior distances – this will depend on entries. Each Clout target is a 15 metre diameter circle which is divided into 5 equal rings, which score from 1 – 5 depending on how close you get to the flag located in the inside ring – 5 being closest to the flag..</p> |
| Dress Code | <p>Just come as you are – no whites or greens required. Remember to wrap up warmly as it can take some time to do the scoring for all the different targets. Archers will all be expected to assist with the scoring throughout the afternoon.</p> |
| Misc information | <p>Arrangements have been made with the owners of the house to give us access to the toilet facilities. As this is a rough field and our shoots are open to all Archers, we shall try to ensure that wheelchair users can make it to the shooting line and toilets. Please call the organiser before booking for a more detailed discussion.</p> |
| It is mandatory that all participants have received instruction in clout shooting before they compete and this will be available on the day for those who haven't, as will a sheet to sign to say you have received instruction. | <p>I certify that I am a member of GNAS or FITA.
