Celtic Challenge 31st July & 1st August 2010

GENERAL

All competitors are asked to register before equipment inspection/practice on both days, at which time they will be able to confirm their target allocation. Please bring GNAS (or other FITA member association) cards as proof of membership. For all competitors the entire competition will be shot at 70 m on the 122 cm face.

At the end of the ranking round the head to head competition will generally take place on the targets to the right of the Director of Shooting's (DoS) tent. The targets to the left of the DoS's tent will usually be available for practice, and will follow the same time control as the competitive matches. Official practice will be available on all targets between the ranking and elimination rounds.

OLYMPIC ROUND - HEAD TO HEAD

Olympic round head to head tournament involve several rounds of knockout matches, where winning archers advance through a series of first Elimination rounds and subsequently Finals round matches, culminating in the Bronze, Silver and Gold Medal Finals.

All archers completing in each day's ranking round will all have the opportunity to participate in the Head to Head round.

When the ranking round scores have been checked and sorted, each archer will be issued with an Olympic round score sheet, which will show their ranking. This will specify which targets they will use, for the remainder of the competition.

Competitors who are not involved in a particular stage of the competition (e.g. archers with compound bows at a time when those with recurve bows are shooting, for example), may not shoot on the competition targets, but will be permitted to use the practice targets

INDIVIDUAL HEAD-TO HEAD (WRS)

There will be four categories, men and women shooting recurve or compound bows. (Within each category, all archers will compete together regardless of age.)

All rounds will be shot as per the new FITA WRS Rules 2010. Elimination rounds will be best of 3 sets (ends) of 6 arrows in 4 minutes. The two opponents for each match will shoot on the same target, with all competitors shooting simultaneously in a single detail.

In the quarter finals and semi finals the competition is best of 5 sets (ends) of 3 arrows in timed ends of two minutes, simultaneously shot in a single detail as before. Each match will be shot with one archer per target, with his or her opponent shooting on the target alongside.

The medal finals matches are shot as best of 5 sets (ends) of 3 arrows in timed ends. The medal finals rounds competitors shoot one arrow at a time in turn, with each match individually timed by a judge. The first archer has 30 seconds to shoot their first arrow. As soon as that archer has shot, the match judge indicates the start of the second archer's 30 second shooting period. The archers continue to alternate their shots in this fashion until each has shot 3 arrows.

FITA rules

7.6.1.4.1 In each set an athlete can score a maximum of 60 (for 6 arrows) or 30 points (for 3 arrows). The athlete with the highest score of that end obtains 2 set points; in case of a tied score both athletes obtain 1 set point.

7.6.1.4.2 As soon as an athlete reaches 4 set points (4 of 6 possible) in a 3 set match or 6 set points (6 of 10) possible in a 5 set match, he is declared winner and passes to the next round.

If match is tied 3-3 (or 5-5) a single arrow shoot off (closest to centre) will be used as a tie break

As in previous years, if entry is low, the organiser may use a modified elimination stage giving all archers a chance for more than 1 H-H match.

If there is sufficient interest and time available on Saturday we will run a handicap mixed team competition followed by a DIY barbeque (bring your own food to cook on our BBQ) - weather permitting

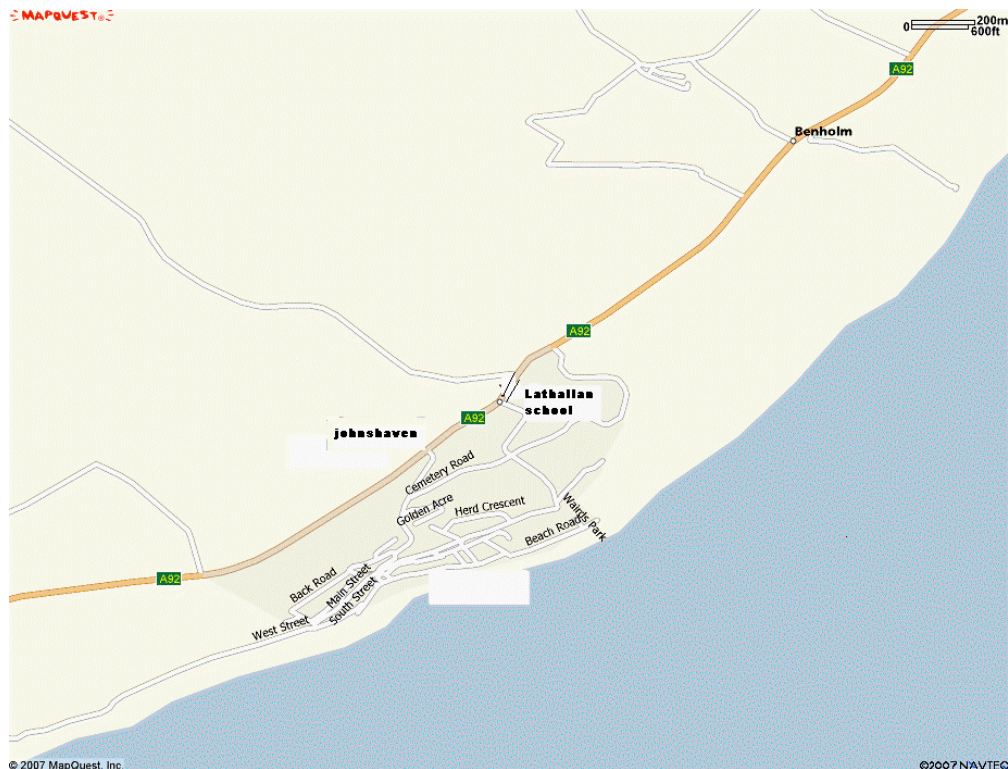
