Scoring	Single scoring (A&B scoring C&D, C&D scoring A&B)

Sighters	One round of Sighters starting at 9:00am.
Start of Competition	Competition will start after the conclusion of sighters and/or inspection as per judges discretion
Special Notes	All lost arrows must be found before archers leave. Due to space constraints there is no area to erect tents however there is a hall for the storage of equipment in the event of bad weather and Gazebo's will be erected for shelter. Disabled Archers wishing to park cars next to the field must indicate this on the entry form Food (breakfast rolls, burgers etc) will be available throughout the day

Drug testing	Archers at this tournament will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Junior entries must be signed by a parent or guardian, giving consent for a drug test to be permitted if sought.

All archers are requested to aid with moving targets between distances and helping to clear the field at the end of the shoot.

All GNAS cards will be inspected. Archers who cannot show a card or receipt will NOT BE PERMITTED TO SHOOT.
