Venue	Penicuik High School Playing Fields, Penicuik, Midlothian, EH26 9BZ
Entry Fee	One Day: Seniors £12.00; Juniors £7.00 Two Days: Seniors £20.00; Juniors £12.00 Juniors who choose to shoot the senior round for senior prizes must pay full adult fee. They will not be eligible for Junior Awards. CHEQUES PAYABLE TO PENICUIK ARCHERS – Refunds – at the organiser’s discretion before closing date – thereafter none given.
Closing Date	Saturday 1 May 2010
Photography	In view of the provisions of the SAA Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy those who wish to take photographs at this event must register with the Tournament Secretary on arrival.
FITA	In addition to the FITA rounds Metrics 1, 2, 3 and 4 may be available. Awards issued will depend on total no of entries received.
Dress Regulations	GNAS Dress regulations apply as per rule 307. GNAS registered alternative shooting colours are accepted.
Fita Practice Arrows	Two ends of practice to commence at 9:00am
Start of competition	Competition will start after the conclusion of practice and / or inspection – as per Judges discretion.
FITA Shooting	Will be shot in the order of 90/70, 70/60, 50 and 30 metres on both days (Or equivalent distances relating to the Metric Rounds) Rule 7.5.1. – There will be four archers per boss Rule 7.4.1. – At 90/70: 70/60: metres 6 arrow ends will be shot within 4 minutes and 50 and 30 metres 3 arrow ends in 2 minutes.
Medals	Awards will be made according to the number of entries received, by the closing date, and based on the following minimum criteria of 2-3 Gold, 4-6 Silver, 7 + Gold, Silver and Bronze. Recurve & Compound: Ladies and Gents (EA Bowl for 1 st place). Other bow styles – tournament organiser’s discretion. Junior: EA Bowls for Highest Double round for both recurve and compound on overall scores, other medals depending on entries. Round shot to be is the minimum for that age group. Distance Awards: Double round only - 1 st place Lady and Gent, but will be dependant on entries. Recurve Ladies Team for Double Round – 2 archers Recurve Gents Team for Double Round – 2 Archers Compound Team – 3 Archers from same club (Mixed gender)
Drug Testing	Archers at this tournament will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Junior entries must be signed by a parent or guardian, giving consent for a drug tested to be permitted, if sought.
