Timings for both days	08:00hrs Registration 08:30hrs Assembly 08:45hrs 45 Minutes practice on tournament field under Judge control Equipment inspection will take place prior to commencement of ranking round Following practice FITA 70metre ranking round – shot as either a double or single detail (dependant on entries), 6 arrows in 4 minutes On completion of the FITA 70m ranking round, there will be a short break whilst archers are seeded for the Olympic Head to Head round. This will be the only planned break during each day. Official practice for the afternoon session will be taken during this time. All archers will go into the Head to Head; higher placed archers will receive a bye in the earliest round.												
Target Awards	The event will be shot in line with the new WRS FITA rules (effective from 1 April 2010). All individual matches will be shot using the set system appropriate to the knock out stage – more information will be provided on the day. FITA Target Awards may be claimed by archers achieving the following scores for the FITA 70m round in accordance with FITA rules
