

SAA Postal League 2010/2011

The nights are getting dark, its cold...that can only mean POSTAL LEAGUE!

Carrying on with last years format, Clubs will shoot against the other teams in their division, one match per month from November to March, as per the table below.

Two points will be awarded for a win, one point for a draw.

Any clubs who want to join the League are welcome, please note that you will be entered a Division with comparable scores , but no team can gain entry to the top division except by promotion .

There are separate leagues for A, B and C teams as well as for recurves, compounds and longbows.

At the end of the season, the bottom team in each division will be relegated and the top team from division 2 and below will be promoted. If teams drop out after the first season, the remaining teams will move up one place.

There will be medals awarded **for the winners in each division of each league**, and for the highest individual scorers across all divisions.

The round to be shot is a Portsmouth, normal GNAS rules to apply. If more than one team is entered, the four highest scores will comprise Team A, the next four highest TeamB etc. The makeup of the teams can therefore change each month .

The entry fee is £6 for the first team, with £3 per extra team for recurves teams. For compound teams the fee will be £3 and £1.50 respectively

They must be submitted with Novembers scores via post, thereafter scores will be accepted by email. All scores submitted will be acknowledged ASAP, but they must be submitted by the first day of the next month. Late submissions will not be accepted.
