About the tournament	Penicuik Archers wish to invite archers along to our Anniversary Tournament to celebrate our first 25 years as a club. The shoot will be won by an archer's performance over the 3 rounds and archers need to complete in all 3 rounds to be considered eligible for an award.

Dates	4 September 2010: Ladies and Gents FITA Rounds 5 September 2010: FITA 70 metre ranking followed by Olympic round - Juniors are welcome to shoot on an equal footing with senior archers and will be required to shoot a Metric 1(Ladies round) as a minimum.												
Entry Fee	All Competitors: Both days £22.00, single day £13.00

Event format and timing:	<p>Saturday 4 September 08:30hrs: Assembly 08:45hrs: 2 ends of practice under Judge control. Following practice: Ladies / Gents FITA round (90m/70m and 70m/60m, two details, 6 arrows in 4 minutes 122cm faces) Lunch Ladies / Gents FITA round (50m and 30m) 3 arrows in 2 minutes, 80cm face</p> <p>Sunday 5 September 08:45hrs: 45mins practice on the field under Judge control Following practice: FITA 70m round – 2 details, 6 arrows in 4 minutes. After the FITA 70M ranking round there will be a break whilst archers are seeded for the H2H round. This will be the only planned break. Official practice for the afternoon session will take place during this time. All archers will go forward into the H2H - higher placed archers may receive a bye in the earliest round.</p> <p>The full programme for the H2H will be available on the day.</p> <p>The event will be shot in line with the current WRS FITA rules.</p>

Prizes	Archers will be allocated points and the prizes will be awarded on Sunday at the conclusion of the shoot. The awards will be based on the combined points accrued from both Saturday and Sunday scores.												
Drug Testing	Archers at the tournament may be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Junior entries must be signed by a parent or guardian, giving consent for drug test to be permitted, if sought.												
Smoking	This is a non-smoking event. If you feel the need to partake Penicuik Archers ask that you retire well behind the tented area.												
Photography	In view of the provisions of the SAA Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register on arrival.												
Lost arrows	All lost arrows must be reported to a judge or a member of the field party. It is the responsibility of the archer to make sure that all arrows are accounted for – before leaving the field.												

Bosses	Penicuik Archers use straw bosses placed on H frame stands for our events.
Car Parking	Would all archers please park their car in the area zoned off for parking. The only archers who will be permitted to park behind the tent line will be wheelchair archers.
GNAS Cards	Archers should have their GNAS or FITA card membership card available for inspection.
Refreshments	Penicuik Archers will be selling food, tea, coffee etc at the event. Any profit from this enterprise will be donated to local charities.
