Program

Morning – Western Area Championship

Ladies/Gents F.I.T.A. 70M, Junior F.I.T.A. 60M

Practice will start at 9:30 a.m.

Equipment inspection will be under the control of the chairman of judges.

Afternoon

Team Head 2 Head, this is a fun event and as such will be shot using a handicap system based on the mornings results.

Fees

Senior £12

Junior £6

(all entry fees are non-returnable)

Full adult fees are chargeable for juniors shooting senior rounds.

SPECIAL NOTES

This is a small field with limited space behind the waiting line therefore no personal tents may be erected, gazebo's will be provided for archers to shelter from the elements and there is a hall to store equipment in during the shoot.

Dress Regulations

As this is a UK Record Status event, all archers will be expected to comply with current G.N.A.S. dress regulations Rule 307

Drug Testing

All archers attending this Tournament will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to provide samples must comply; if any competitor refuses to undertake a drug test that refusal will be treated as a positive result.

Entry Forms submitted on behalf of archers under the age of 18 must be signed by their parent or guardian confirming that they agree to abide by this rule, and authorising drug testing on such competitors.

Insurance

This tournament is only open to members of G.N.A.S. or other recognized Archery Society affiliated to F.I.T.A.

All archers must be able to produce their G.N.A.S. membership cards (or other written evidence of membership from their Club Secretary on the day of the tournament if so requested by the Judge or Tournament Organiser. Archers unable to do so may not be permitted to shoot.

Child Protection:

The SAA takes its responsibility in relation to Child Protection legislation (including vulnerable adults) extremely seriously. This shoot will therefore be run in accordance with the Child Protection procedures as defined by GNAS and SAA.

Parents / Guardians Please Note:

Parents, or their representatives, will be responsible for the care of those children while those children participate in this tournament. The WoSAA and Clyde Arrows have no control over photography at this event.

Shooting – FITA 70m/60m

The following method of shooting will be adopted:

- There will be a maximum of four archers per boss.
- 6 arrow ends will be shot within 4 minutes

Scoring

In accordance with G.N.A.S. Rules the following scoring system will be adopted:

Double score boards whereby two archers record all the scores and if there is a discrepancy between the two boards, the lower score will be counted.
