<b>Venue</b>	Penicuik High School Playing Fields, Penicuik, Midlothian, EH26 9BZ
<b>Dates</b>	<p><b>18 June 2011:</b> Ladies and Gents FITA Rounds</p> <p><b>19 June 2011:</b> FITA 70 metre ranking followed by Olympic round -</p> <p><b>Juniors</b> are welcome to shoot on an equal footing with senior archers and will be required to shoot a Metric 1(Ladies round) as a minimum.</p>
<b>Entry Fee</b>	<p>All Competitors: Both days £22.00, single day £13.00</p> <p>Before the closing date refunds will be at the discretion of the tournament organiser and after the closing date has passed no refunds will be issued.</p> <p>Cheques payable to Penicuik Archers (please ensure that you put the correct value of stamps on our envelope if posting your entry).</p>
<b>Closing Date</b>	4 June 2011 or when shoot full. Space is limited and these will be reserved on a first come first served basis)
<b>Event format and timing:</b>	<p><b>Saturday 18 June 2011 Gents and Ladies FITA</b></p> <p>08:30hrs: Assembly</p> <p>08:45hrs: Up to 45 Mins of practice under Judge control.</p> <p>Following practice: Ladies / Gents FITA round (90m/70m and 70m/60m, two details, 6 arrows in 4 minutes 122cm faces)</p> <p>Lunch</p> <p>Ladies / Gents FITA round (50m and 30m) 3 arrows in 2 minutes, 80cm face the event will be shot in line with the current WRS FITA rules.</p> <p><b>Sunday 19 June 2011 70metre &amp; H2H</b></p> <p><b>Note: the set system will be used during H2H</b></p> <p>08:30 Assembly</p> <p>08:45hrs: Up to 45mins practice on the field under Judge control</p> <p>Following practice: FITA 70m round – 2 details, 6 arrows in 4 minutes.</p> <p>After the FITA 70M ranking round there will be a break whilst archers are seeded for the H2H round. This will be the only planned break. Official practice for the afternoon session will take place during this time. All archers will go forward into the H2H - higher placed archers may receive a bye in the earliest round.</p> <p>The full H2H programme will be available on the day.</p>
<b>Judges</b>	Bill MacKay, Chairman of Judges: Derek Sangster, Director of Shooting + the judging team.
<b>Target Awards</b>	FITA Star and FITA Target Awards may be claimed by archers achieving the prerequisite scores.
<b>Prizes</b>	<p>Archers will be allocated points and the prizes will be awarded on Sunday at the conclusion of the shoot. The awards will be based on the combined points accrued from both Saturday and Sunday scores.</p> <p>Awards: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> &amp; 4<sup>th</sup> Recurve, Compounds, Ladies, Gentlemen</p> <p>Other bow styles: awards will be given at tournament organiser's discretion.</p>
<b>Drug Testing</b>	Archers at the tournament may be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Junior entries must be signed by a parent or guardian, giving consent for drug test to be permitted, if sought.
<b>Smoking</b>	This is a non-smoking event. If you feel the need to partake Penicuik Archers ask that you retire well behind the tented area.

<b>Photography</b>	In view of the provisions of the SAA Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register on arrival.
<b>Lost arrows</b>	All lost arrows <b>must</b> be reported to a judge or a member of the field party. It is the responsibility of the archer to make ensure that all their arrows are accounted for – before leaving the field.
<b>Bosses</b>	Penicuik Archers use straw bosses placed on H frame stands for our events.
<b>Car Parking</b>	Would all archers please park their car in the area zoned off for parking. Wheelchair / and some disabled archers who are travelling on their own may be permitted to park their car behind the tent line. Otherwise you will be asked to park within the car park area. The car parking arrangement may be reviewed on the weekend of the tournament.
<b>GNAS Cards</b>	Archers should have their GNAS or FITA card membership card available for inspection.
<b>Refreshments</b>	Penicuik Archers will be selling food (bacon butties, burgers etc and hot and cold drinks will be also be available throughout the weekend.
<b>Target Lists and Results</b>	Results and Target lists will be available from the SAA Websites ( <a href="http://www.scottisharchery.org.uk/events">www.scottisharchery.org.uk/events</a> ) The results will also be available from Archery UK website.
