<b>Dates</b>	Saturday 3 & Sunday 4 September 2011
<b>Venue</b>	Penicuik High School Playing Fields, Penicuik, Midlothian, EH26 9BZ
<b>Entry Fee</b>	One Day: Seniors £13.00; Juniors £7.00 Two Days: Seniors £22.00; Juniors £12.00 Juniors who choose to shoot the senior round for senior prizes must pay full adult fee. They will not be eligible for Junior Awards. <b>CHEQUES PAYABLE TO PENICUIK ARCHERS – Refunds – organiser’s discretion before closing date – thereafter none given.</b>
<b>Closing Date</b>	<b>Saturday 20 August 2011</b>
<b>Photography</b>	In view of the provisions of the SAA Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy those who wish to take photographs at this event must register on arrival.
<b>FITA</b>	In addition to the FITA rounds, Metric 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 rounds may be available. Awards issued will depend on total no of entries received per category.
<b>Dress Regs</b>	GNAS Dress regulations apply as per rule 307.
<b>Practice</b>	Two ends of practice to commence at 9:00am – <b>that’s 2 minutes per end on the Sunday!</b>
<b>Start of competition</b>	Competition will start after the conclusion of practice and / or inspection – as per Judges discretion.
<b>FITA Shooting</b>	<b>Will be shot in accordance with FITA rules of shooting.</b> Rounds will be conducted in the order of 90/70, 70/60, 50 and 30 metres on Saturday. <b>On Sunday the distances will be shot in reverse starting at the shortest distance and working back to the longest distance (Reverse FITA).</b> Rule 7.5.1. – There will be four archers per boss Rule 7.4.1. – At 90/70: 70/60: metres 6 arrow ends will be shot within 4 minutes and 50 & 30 metres 3 arrow ends within 2 minutes.
<b>Bosses</b>	Penicuik Archers use straw bosses on H frames.
<b>Medals</b>	Awards will be made according to the number of entries received, by the closing date, and based on the following criteria of 2-3 Gold, 4-6 Silver, 7 + Gold, Silver and Bronze. <b>Recurve &amp; Compound:</b> Ladies and Gents (Trophies for 1 <sup>st</sup> place). <b>Other bow styles</b> – Awards dependant on entries and at tournament organiser’s discretion. <b>Junior:</b> Highest Double round for both recurve and compound on overall scores, other medals depending on entries. The round entered is to the minimum for that age group. <b>Distance Awards:</b> Double round only - 1 <sup>st</sup> place Lady and Gent, award given will be dependant on entries. <b>Recurve Team:</b> Double Round only – 3 archers from the same club (Mixed gender) <b>Compound Team:</b> Double Round only– 3 Archers from same club (Mixed gender)
<b>Drug testing</b>	WRS tournaments are liable for drug testing and any competitors approached to give samples must comply; if they refuse that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Junior entries must be signed by a parent or guardian, giving consent for a drug tested to be permitted, if sought.
<b>Judges</b>	Bill Mackay, Chairman of Judges
<b>Patron</b>	Martin Symonds, Chairman Penicuik Archers.
<b>General information</b>	All competitors must be GNAS / FITA members and will be required to produce their membership cards or proof of affiliation during Registration. By entering this competition you are agreeing that you are a fully paid up member of either association. <b>All lost arrows must be found before archers leave - this is a school playing field</b> The organiser or Midlothian Council will not be responsible for any loss or damage howsoever caused. Entry to competition will be taken as acceptance of these conditions.
