<b>COMPOUND</b>	18m FITA 40cm triple vertical face Faces arranged in four columns A – C – B – D
<b>General Information</b>	Double detail. 4 Archers per boss
<b>FEES</b>	£9.00 per person – <b>Refunds at organisers discretion and none given after closing date.</b>

<b>PRIZES</b>	<b>Will be awarded to Ladies and Gents as follows:</b> Ladies and Gents - Recurve, Compound, Longbow and Barebow will be based on the following entry criteria (2-3 = Gold, 4-6 = Silver, 7+ = Bronze) <b>or at the organisers discretion.</b> For archers who elect to shoot in both sessions only the first round shot will count for a placing within the Scottish Championship even if both rounds are shot using different bow types. Classification prizes - 1 <sup>st</sup> place only - Certificate (minimum of two entrants per class). <b>Note:</b> there is no novice category at the Senior Championships Visitors awards according to entry (minimum of two entrants in class) Team awards - single club <b>1<sup>st</sup> Ladies Recurve Team (2 Ladies) 1<sup>st</sup> Gents Recurve Team (3 Gents)</b> <b>1<sup>st</sup> Compound Team (3 archers - mixed gender)</b> Improvement Prize (Open) – highest score improvement for 2nd 30 arrows compared to 1st 30. Presidents Prize (Open) – awarded to archer competing in the Scottish Indoor Championships (SIC) for the first time Chiltern Trophy – SAA Junior who shoots the highest score with a Recurve bow. Scott Mould Trophy – SAA Junior who shoots the highest score with a Compound Bow.
