Scoring	Single scoring: No archer shall record his/her own score.
Dress	As per new regulations
Shooting	3 arrows in 2 min: 2 ends of sighters: Alternating AB/CD throughout.
Start of shooting	09:40 approx. Morning Session. 13:30 approx. Afternoon Session
Open Awards	Medals for each category, depending on number entries.
WoSAA Member Awards	Recurve: Lady & Gentleman; Perpetual Trophy Club Team ; Perpetual Trophy Compound: Lady & Gentleman; Perpetual Trophy Club Team ; Perpetual Trophy Longbow Individual ; Perpetual Trophy U18 Recurve: Lady & Gentleman U18 Compound Lady & Gentleman Medals for U12, U14, and U16
Other awards	Awards for other bow and archer classes will be considered upon receipt of sufficient entries by the closing date.
Notes	Awards offered in each competitor group will be determined by the number of valid entries received by the closing date, generally in accordance with SAA guidelines. A junior (U18), competing in the full event, shall not be excluded from U18 awards.
Drug Testing	Archers competing at a record status tournament will be liable for drug testing and a competitor approached to give samples must comply. A refusal will be treated as a positive result. Under 18 entries must be signed by a parent/guardian prior to the start of the event to signify their consent to their son / daughter / ward being tested if approached.
Judges	Alistair Paton and Michael Mather
Under 18	Parents/Guardians will, at all times, be responsible for those under 18 that are present.
Other Information	If you have concerns about possible pass through, bring suitable backing material.
