

# Scottish Archery National Rankings 2022

V1.4, May 2021

# **Introduction**

- 1. The Scottish Rankings are open for **all** members of Scottish Archery to take part.
- 2. The Scottish Rankings for each year are decided by the number of points an archer gains from their top 6 results during the calendar year.
- 3. The rankings will be published monthly from mid-April on the Scottish Archery website.
  - a. Only one result is required to qualify for the Scottish Rankings
  - b. If an archer shoots more than 6 events, only their highest sets of points will be used.
  - c. Ranking points will expire 12 months after they were gained.
- 4. The final rankings for any given year will determine the Scottish Number 1 ranked archer. These will be published mid October.
- 5. Each month we will also publish rankings based on the seasons best WA720 score irrespective of which level it was shot at. (Non WA720 scores can be converted).

### Levels

6. There are 3 Levels of events in 2022, each providing opportunities for archers to score ranking points

### 7. Gold events are:

- a. The 4 Scottish Tour Stages.
- b. The Scottish Championships.
- c. Archery GB tier 2+ events.
- d. Archery GB tier 1 events (These will be weighted at 1.5x the points allocated in the gold table)
- e. World Ranking Events (These will be weighted at 2x the points allocated in the gold table).

### 8. Silver events are:

- a. Any other WRS/UKRS shoot or any SRS shoot that contains head to head.
- b. Any Archery GB tier 2 or 3 events.
- c. Junior/Cadet shoots that fit with the above (eg JNOC, key stage events)

### 9. Bronze events are:

- a. Any other SRS shoot.
- b. Our new Scottish Ranking Events will also come under bronze and will be weighted at 0.5x the points allocated in the bronze table.
- 10. All events listed above would be considered 'open' as would any events with specific entry requirements such as the Paralympics, Olympics, age group events or World Cup Stages. All record status events must be advertised as 'open' events for ranking points to be awarded. The only exception is Scottish Ranking Events which may well be focused at local clubs and their members (but still require to be registered shoots).

### **Ranking Points**

13. The number of points awarded will depend on the Level and position of the archer at the end of each competition. Points are awarded for position places from 1<sup>st</sup> to 64<sup>th</sup>. These are shown in Appendix 1.

The following sections outline how points will be awarded for various events.

### 14. Head to Head rounds:

- a. Points will be awarded for **both** the WA 70m/WA 50m rounds and the final Head to Head position.
- b. If an archer does not compete in the Head to Head, they will only receive points for their qualification position.
- c. If an archer only shoots a single WA 70/WA 50m round in a double round they will be awarded points for their total score.

# 15. Multiple days and/or rounds:

- a. For events held over multiple days (e.g. a WA 70m/H2H and a WA 1440) each day will be classed as a separate event and the points awarded will be from the applicable Tier and position.
- b. For events that have multiple rounds on the same day (WA 70m/WA 50m) points will be awarded on the combined total of the double round.
- c. For events where a WA 70m/WA 50m qualifying round is shot then followed by a team or mixed team event points will only be awarded for the qualifying event.

# **Providing Results**

- 17. For events out with Scotland it is the responsibility of the Archer to complete the online form here if they want the result to go towards their ranking, this must be done within 1 week of the results being published. For Scottish events the TO will send on the results.
  - a. Scottish Archery will have a rankings group to administer the system and verify submissions against results.
  - b. If the 1 week limit cannot be achieved then a notification must be sent to rankings@scottisharchery.org.uk as soon as possible.
  - c. If results are submitted or received late from any event or claim are consistently inaccurate, Scottish Archery's rankings group has complete discretion as to whether they will be accepted.

## **Disputes & Questions**

- 20. Any dispute or questions about a Scottish Ranking position/points total should be directed to <a href="mailto:rankings@scottisharchery.org.uk">rankings@scottisharchery.org.uk</a> no later than 1 week after the release of the most recent ranking list.
  - a. The appeal must have supporting evidence.
  - b. Scottish Archery will respond within 1 week of the appeal and may publish the appeal outcome.
  - c. Appeals will be considered by a panel led by Scottish Archery's Pathway Manager.
- 21. Any necessary rule changes to be made, will be published towards the end of 2022 for the 2023 season.
