SCOTTISH ARCHERY CODE OF ETHICS

Policy Statement

The content of this Code of Ethics applies to all those involved within the sport of Archery and should be read in conjunction with other Scottish Archery policies and procedures, as noted below.

All individuals will at all times:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person, be they adult or child, treating everyone equally within the context of the sport.
- Respect the spirit of the sport adhering to the rules and laws [Of Scottish Archery](#), [Archery GB](#), [and World Archery](#) on and off of the shooting field, incorporating the concept of friendship and respect for others.
- Promote the positive aspects of the sport and never condone the use of inappropriate or abusive language, inappropriate relationships, bullying, harassment, discrimination or physical violence.
- Accept responsibility for their own behaviour and encourage and guide all Scottish Archery members and parents of junior members to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and conduct.
- Ensure all concerns of a child safeguarding nature are referred in accordance with the Scottish Archery Child Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy and Procedures
- Conduct themselves in a manner that takes all reasonable measures to protect their own safety and the safety of others.
- Promote the reputation of the sport and never behave, encourage or condone others to behave in a manner that is liable to bring the sport into disrepute.

 - Scottish Archery Child Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy and Procedures
 - Scottish Archery Anti-Doping Policy
 - Scottish Archery Equality Policy and Procedures

 - Scottish Archery Codes of Conduct
